### the Basics

### **PARTICIPATE**

If you haven't already, register now so you are ready to watch, bid, and participate! The Handbid website will prompt you to download the mobile app (which we recommend), but you can use the mobile website or desktop website.

### **TUNE IN**

On 10/22, you can start the live stream at 6:30pm via the Handbid mobile app or the Handbid event site.

### **PAYMENTS**

When you register, you'll be asked to enter your credit card info. You will not be charged unless you win an item & your card will be processed on 10/23 at 5pm, unless you choose to run your card before this time via your Handbid account. This also gives you the option to change your card or request an another payment method, such as a check.

If you prefer to send a check, (written to ACT and mailed to 1140 Monroe Ave NW Ste 4101 Grand Rapids, MI 49503), let us know by 10/23 at 3pm so your card isn't charged while your check is en route.

Handbid is a secure platform; you can find info on their privacy policies and credit card/information security measures on their main website.

### **GATHERING WITH A GROUP?**

On 10/22, play the live stream on your TV by hooking up an HMDI cord to your laptop or just leave a computer in a central location with the volume high. Since our auction platform also has an app (search @Handbid), you & your guests can bid from your personal devices.

### **SILENT AUCTION** — 10/15 at 5pm until 10/22 at 8:30pm

The silent auction is open! See the **PARTICIPATE** area on the left for how to register so you can bid on items.

**PREMIERE / MAIN EVENT** — 10/22; live stream begins at 6:30pm for art demonstrations & program runs from 7pm-8pm

**ART DEMONSTRATIONS** Tune into the live event starting at 6:30pm! The official program kicks off at 7pm, but we are launching the stream a bit earlier so you have time to get connected and see two artists in action, featuring ACT Student Maurice Beckford and Teaching Artist Becky Baker. We'll also be offering some tips on using Handbid during the time in case you are still getting connected to the platform.

**LIVE AUCTION** Led by professional auctioneer Greg Bator, the live auction will be immersed within the live stream event! The live auction will feature five items (see the card insert or event site for details) and bidding will begin for these items at the start of the live stream at 7pm on 10/22, and close for the live auction items during the program; be sure to follow along so you don't miss out on live auction items and packages!

### **FUND-A-NEED CAMPAIGN** — 10/15 at 5pm until 10/25 at 5pm

EVERY donation of any amount makes a difference! You'll find a custom amount option on the auction website in addition to the levels below.

- ▶ \$1,000 is the cost of an artist residency for a local special education classroom, which can take place virtually if needed
- ▶ \$500 supports supplies, framing, and sales for ACT apprentices, who are young adults training as professional artists
- ▶ \$250 supports the cost of ACT's monthly Open Studio series, which is currently being offered virtually and for small in-person groups
- ▶ \$100 supports the cost of art supplies for a group participating in a multi-week classes at the ACT Studio
- ▶ \$50 supports the costs of scholarships for studio & virtual classes
