Private Music Instruction

All Sessions: 45 minutes

An ACT teaching artist will meet you virtually or in-person to provide one-on-one music instruction in guitar, piano, drum, ukulele. Each session lasts one hour, and times and location are scheduled to fit your needs. Students must have their own instrument.





In-Person Classes

Teaching Artist: Krista Pischner-Coon Create a simple, harmonious sculpture using circles made with rings of reed and decorative papers in a variety of colors and patterns.

Teaching Artist: Kat VanHammen Use mirrors, canvas, and paint to create a beautiful piece of artwork that your friends and family will love! Pieces will need to be picked up at a later date to allow for drying time.
